Thank you for purchasing FUZZY WordPress Theme. This document will make it as easy as possible to build your site with the FUZZY WordPress Theme. It is recommended that you read it before starting the build of your page. If you still come up with any problems or just a info question about the theme, you are free to leave a comment under the FUZZY Theme on the ThemeForest.

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1 Getting started

The chapter shows some basic instructions how to set up the FUZZY WordPress Theme. The FUZZY is Responsive ONE SLIDE Wordpress Theme. Its clean and simple and focused to that what visitor want to see. And also SEO is very good.

1.1 Installing the FUZZY theme

To set up the **FUZZY** theme folow the steps below:

If you don't have the WordPress installed, then installed it. You have two options to install **FUZZY THEME** (choose **only one** of this steps):

1. You downloaded fuzzy-package.zip. Unzip this. Inside this zip you can see **folder** called **fuzzy**. Upload this folder with some FTP program (like FileZilla) to your *wp_instalation_folder/wp-content/themes/*
2. the second option is to install the theme using WordPress Upload. To do this go to Appearance > Themes > Install Themes > Upload and upload the **fuzzy.zip** file from **fuzzy-package.zip**
3. go to admin -> Appearance -> Themes to activate the theme
4. the theme options are visible after you activate theme in Appearance -> Theme Options

1.2 Seting up like in preview (THE BEST/EASIEST/FASTEST WAY)

First go to **Settings -> Permalinks**. Then you can see **Common Settings** and choose **Post name**. This is for better SEO permalinks and that the **FUZZY** theme will work properly.

1.3 Slider and slogan

First go to **Appearance -> Theme Options -> Home Settings**. You will see some options like image under. Write something for the slogan.

1.3.1 Add some slides to slider

Go to Admin -> Slider -> Add New. Write some title and set featured image. The best size of images is 960px (width) and 345px (height).

If you want some caption under image write some text in content area and scroll down to »Show caption on slide« and set to YES.

If you want images to be linkable to some other web address then insert some link to field called »Slide URL«. You must add URL with »http://«.

2. Header

2.1 Setting the logo

Go to **Admin -> Appearance -> Theme Options**. Under **General Settings** you will see **Logo** to upload. Click on button Upload Image and select your logo from the disk. Dont forget to save the changes below.

2.2 Create the Menu Pages -> **see image in folder documentation/ images-HELP/ pages-creating.jpg)**

For creating the **menu**, you just create some pages. Go to **Pages-> Add New**. Write some title.

Notice: Every page that have some shortcodes inside, you can find the code in folder documentation in file example-codes.html (open file with some html editor-right click open with...)

Home page - when creating Home page just scroll down and see dropdown menu »Page template«. Here you must choose **Home**. **In the content area write anything, or just use shortcodes... or copy/paste code from file example-codes.html**

Blog page – when creating Blog page just scroll down and see dropdown menu »Page template«. Here you must choose **Blog**. **Dont write** anything in page content area. For creating posts go to **chapter (4.1 Create post for blog)**.

Contact page – when creating Contact page just scroll down and see dropdown menu »Page template«. Here you must choose **Contact**. In the preview are some data(address, phone, mail,...) under google maps. This data you can write in the page content area... **or copy/paste code from file example-codes.html**.

Portfolio page – when creating Portfolio page just scroll down and see dropdown menu »Page template«. Here you must choose **Portfolio**. At the bottom is also option for showing the filter (YES/NO). For creating portfolio items go to **chapter (3. Creating portfolio items)**.

For changing the font family and colors and other stuff for the menu, go to **Appearance -> Theme Options -> Font Settings** and scroll down. You will see the section for the MENU.

The MAIN thing that you must to know is, when you choose/create **Portfolio page** or **Blog page**, **dont write** anything in the content area.

For changing the font family and colors and other stuff for the menu, go to **Appearance -> Theme Options -> Font Settings** and scroll down.

For setting the font family you have to go to <http://www.google.com/webfonts/> and choose your font (if you leave this field blank then the wil be the font like in preview).

Example if we use one font from Google Fonts (this font we choose random, you can choose other):

Font Family: font-family: 'Emblema One', cursive;

Font URL: <link href='http://fonts.googleapis.com/css?family=Emblema+One' rel='stylesheet' type='text/css'>

2.3 Submenu settings

First go to **Pages-> Add New**. Then write some title, you can add some content in page content area (please use the shortcode button). On the right side you can see **»Page Attributes«**. From the dropdown menu select the parent page that you wish to be the submenu...

2.4 Header Background

Go to **Appearance -> Theme Options -> Background Settings**. You can set the background image, background color and position/repeating. You can write css values for formatting the image:

- **repeat** (this will repeat background image in x-direction and y-direction)
- **repeat-y** (this will repeat image only on vertical direction)
- **repeat-x** (this will repeat image only on horizontal direction)
- **center top** (this will put image on center at the top)

3. Creating portfolio items

3.1 Create portfolio categories

Go to **Portfolio -> Portfolio Categories**. Now add some categories and save them. This has to be done because of filtering options -> if you choose to show the filter, when creating the page...


On the live site we created **City, Design, Photo, Popup, Video**.

3.2 Add portfolio items

You have two options to show your portfolio items. Like in **popup** or in **slide panel** with some description. This can be set for the each portfolio item.

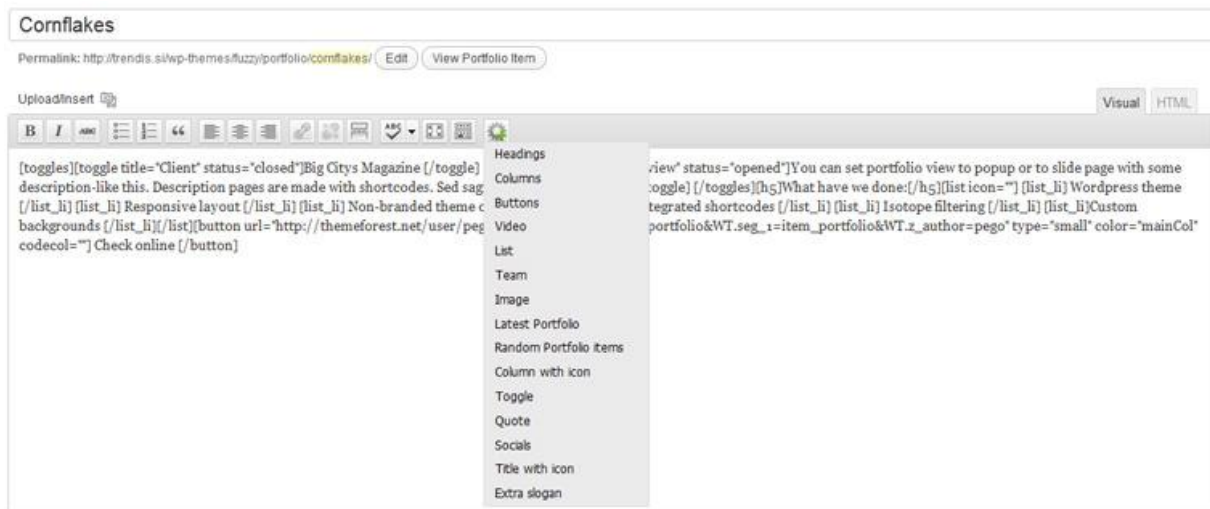
Go to **Portfolio -> Add New**. Write some title.

If you scroll down you can see **»Opening Type«**. For each item you can set if you want to open like in **popup** or with some **description** (example **»Cornflakes«**).



OK, now if you choosed to be portfolio item opened with some description then you have to write some content in content area. You can use **shortcodes** or just **copy the code** from file example

codes.html (this file is located in folder documentation-open file example-codes with some html editor).



3.2.1 Create portfolio item - IMAGE

Go to **Portfolio -> Add New**. Enter the title in the title section, write some description (chapter before) in content area and set featured image (this is portfolio image nothing else ☺). For the featured image there are no rules how big must be image, because images will be resized auto.

Then choose some category (which you made in chapter before) because of function of filtering.

Then scroll down and you can see **Portfolio options/Type** and choose **Image**!



3.2.2 Create portfolio item - VIDEO

Here is the same procedure like in section 3.2.1. Just in portfolio options instead of **Image** choose **Video**.

IMPORTANT!

Scroll down and you can see **Portfolio video options**. Here you must fill both fields (look image below).

For adding links for video portfolio item you have 2 options.

First is **Video URL(iframe)**. This video will be shown only on portfolio item with description (chapter 3.2).

Second is **Video URL(embed link)**. This video will be shown only on popup view-if you choosed popup view in chapter 3.2

3.2.3 Create portfolio item - SLIDESHOW

Here is the same procedure like in section 3.2.1. Just in portfolio options instead of **Image** choose **Slideshow**.

IMPORTANT!

When you are **creating featured image**, just **drag and drop multiple** images and set **ONLY ONE** for the featured image.

3.3 Styling portfolio and filter

Go to Admin-> Appearance -> Theme Options -> Portfolio/Blog Settings. You can see alot of options for setting the font, colors, titles and other stuff. Its not hard just with clicks...

4. Create blog page

Go to **Pages -> Add New**. Write some title (in preview is BLOG). Scroll down to Page options. Where it says Page template, choose **Blog** from dropdown menu.

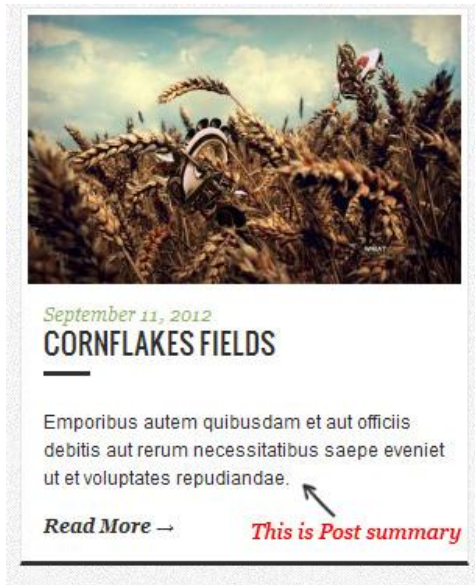
4.1 Create post for blog

Go to **Posts -> Add New**. Write some title, write some content text (you can use **shortcodes**), set featured image. Scroll down to General post options and choose **Image**. Save it.

If you want to have **Slideshow** of images in post just choose Slideshow. Only what is different from Image post is that, when you creating featured image, you must drag and drop multiple images and set only one for the featured image (like section when creating portfolio item slideshow).

If you want to have **Video** in post, just choose Video. Plus you must add some URL for video and set some featured image. Look below into General post options, and you will see **Video URL**. Insert some url to Video...

If you look down you will see some input field **Post summary**. This is some short text that will be shown on the **blog page** ->**NOT in the post**.

4.2 Create post categories

Go to **Post-> Categories**. You will see something like this-image below.

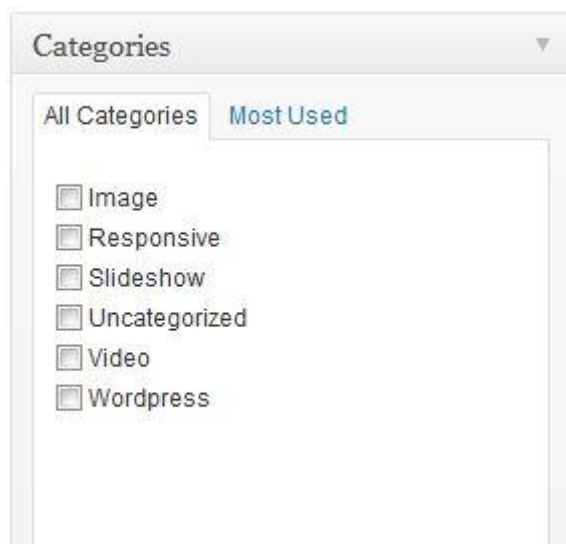

Then when you will creating new post you will see on the right side all categories that you created.
On the live preview site is something like this-image below.

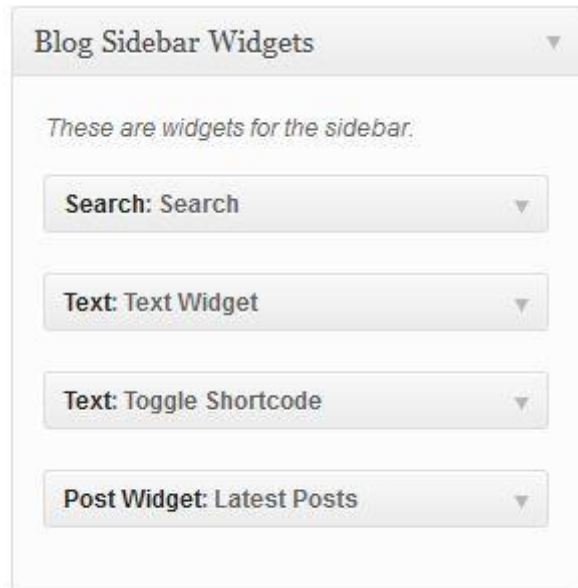


4.3 Blog sidebar

In sidebar you can add any sidebar that is available. We have included 3 custom widgets (Latest Post, Twitter Widget and Flickr widget).

In sidebar you can **add shortcodes**. For example if you want some **toggle** in **sidebar**. Go to **Pages -> New**. Click on **Shortcodes button** and make some toggle shortcode. Then just **copy this code**, and **DONT** save the page.

Then go to **Appearance -> Widgets**. On the right you can see **Blog Sidebar Widgets**. Drag and drop the Text widget to the Blog Sidebar Widgets. **Paste the copied code** into text widget and save it. That is everything...



For example we have on the preview Search Widget, Text Widget with text, Text Widget with shortcodes toggle and Custom Post widget.

5. Footer columns

Footer is created so that it has 4 columns. In this columns you can add any **widget** or any **shortcode**. Go to **Appearance -> Widgets**. On the right side you can see **Footer First Column Sidebar**, **Footer Second Column Sidebar**, **Footer Third Column Sidebar** and **Footer Fourth Column Sidebar**.

For example on the live preview in the First is Text widget with some inline coding (css), in the Second is Twitter Widget, in the Third is Flickr Widget and in the Fourth is Text widget with text and some Social icons shortcodes (how to add shortcodes into widget go to chapter 4.3 Blog sidebar).

6. Create contact page

Go to **Pages -> Add New**. Write some title (in the preview is Contact Us). Scroll down to Page options and choose **Contact**.

As you can see in the preview, next to **contact form** is some data (title Where we are, some contact details,...). This data you can write in page content area-**you can use shortcodes** (if you want like in preview online, just copy/paste code from folder documentation, file example-codes.html).

6.1 Contact google map settings and contact form

Go to **Appearance -> Theme Options -> Contact Page**.

7. Other Pages

7.1 Create some page with external link

You want to click in the menu to some page and you want redirect to external link.

Go to **Pages -> Add New**. Write some title. Scroll down and see where it say **Insert link of the external page**. Just put into some external link... And save it

Insert link of the external page

Enter the link only if you want to include the external page.

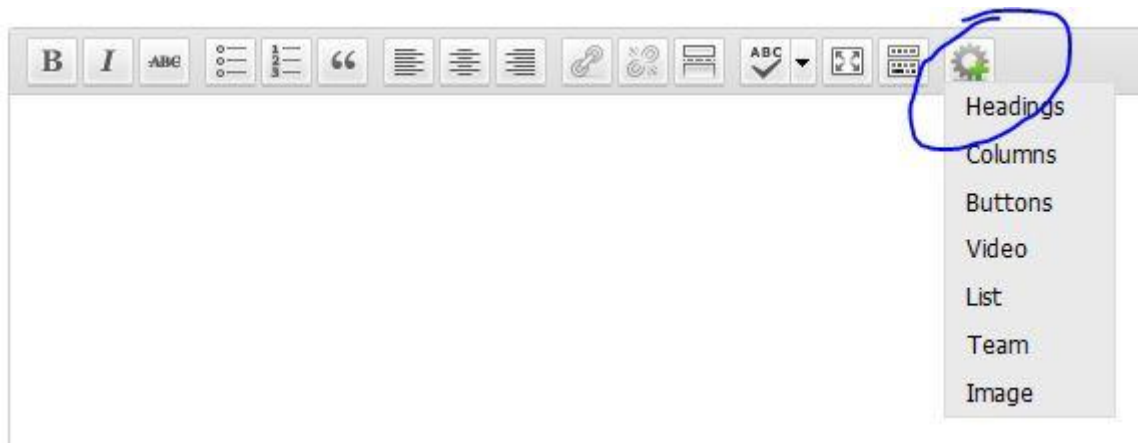
7.2 Create some page with NO link

Please go to preview of **FUZZY** and click in the **MENU** on **About us**. Then will appear submenu **Just** -> click on it and nothing happens. We decided that on click this page is not showing any content and do not go to some external link.

So, if you want that kind of page, go to **Pages -> Add New**. Scroll down and you can see »Show page content on your site?«, just choose NO.

7.3 Create some page with shortcodes

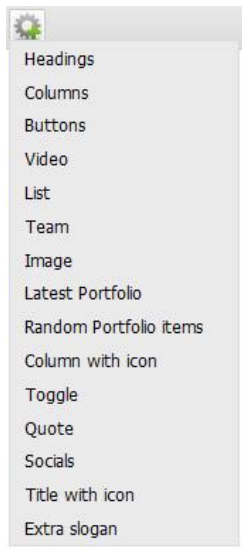
Go to **Pages -> Add New**. Write some title. In the content area you can add any shortcode that is available. Click on the button -> see image below. Everything is on click.



Subpages **ABOUT US** and **OUR SERVICES** are **FULLY MADE WITH SHORTCODES**. Pages Contact, Single Portfolio and Home are made with some shortcodes. Grab the code in file example-codes.html in folder documentation.

8. Shortcodes



FUZZY theme gives you an option to set up your own pages by using shortcodes. **We will not describe shortcodes one by one, because it is very easy to use them. You can check some of the shortcodes live on page Shortcodes.**



OPEN FILE [example-codes.html](#) in folder [documentation](#) with some code editor (like notepad c++, coda,..) or with text notepad.

Inside this file is code for pages in preview made with shortcodes. You can use it...

10. Translatable ready (.po/.mo)

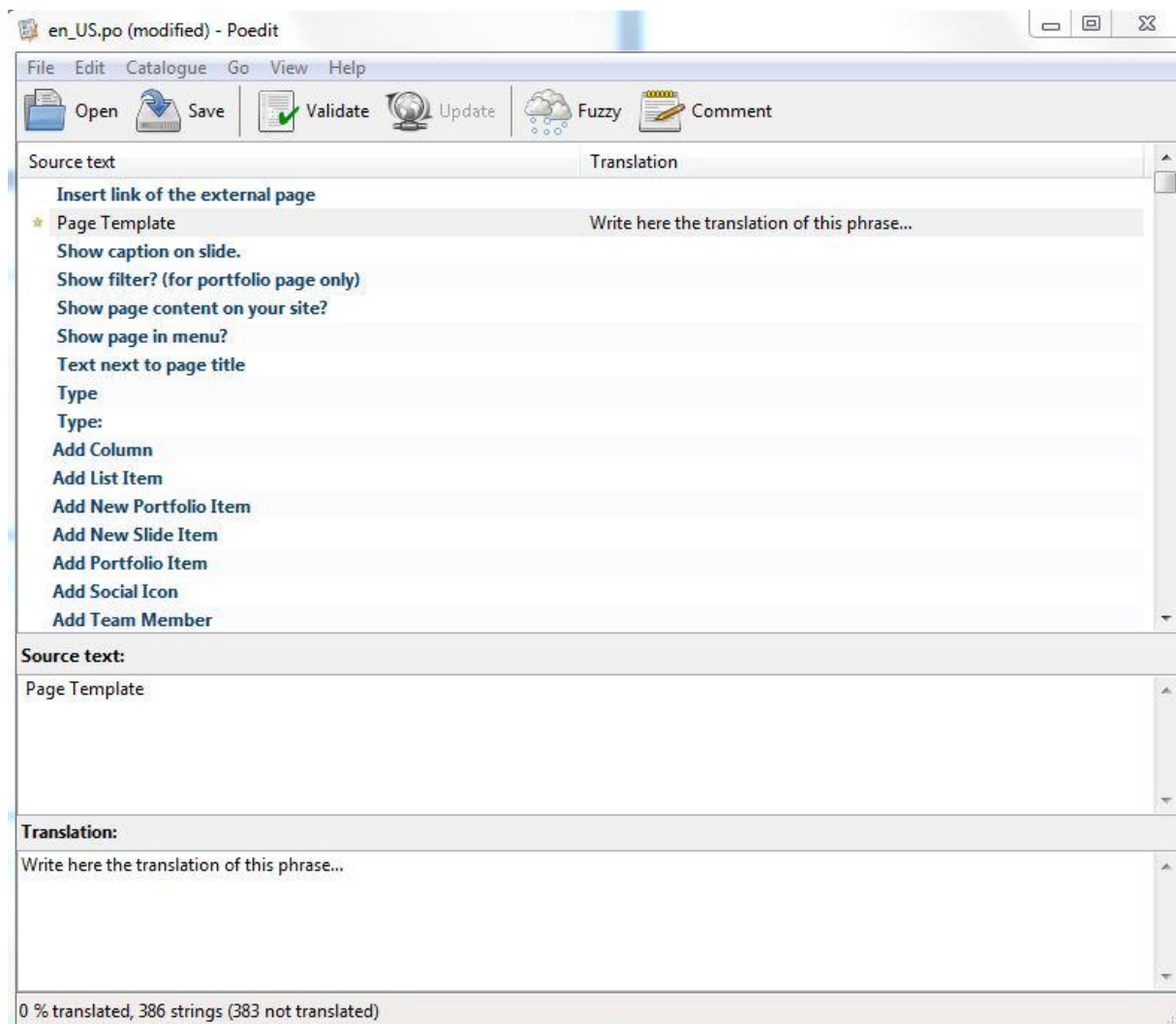
Theme FUZZY is translatable ready, files .po/.mo are included in folder fuzzy-package/fuzzy/languages.

You can see »en_US.po« and »en_US.mo«.

10.1 Translate

First download some software, we used poedit (<http://www.poedit.net/>).

Then with this software open file called »en_US.po«. Now you can translate the words.



For example, if you translated into **French language**, then the best way to save the file is **fr_FR.po**, if to **Spanish language** then save file to **es_ES.po**, and so on (you can check for this names here http://www.gnu.org/software/gettext/manual/html_chapter/gettext_16.html#Country-Codes).

After you saved to .po file will auto be compiled .mo file.

And the last thing to do, go to your root folder of wordpress installatin (not theme installation) and find file **wp-config.php**. Find this line: **define ('WPLANG', '');** For example if you saved file .po to name **fr_FR** then replace **define ('WPLANG', '');** with **define ('WPLANG', 'fr_FR');**
